For our hearing impaired friends: Personal hearing devices are available. Our ushers will be glad to assist you.

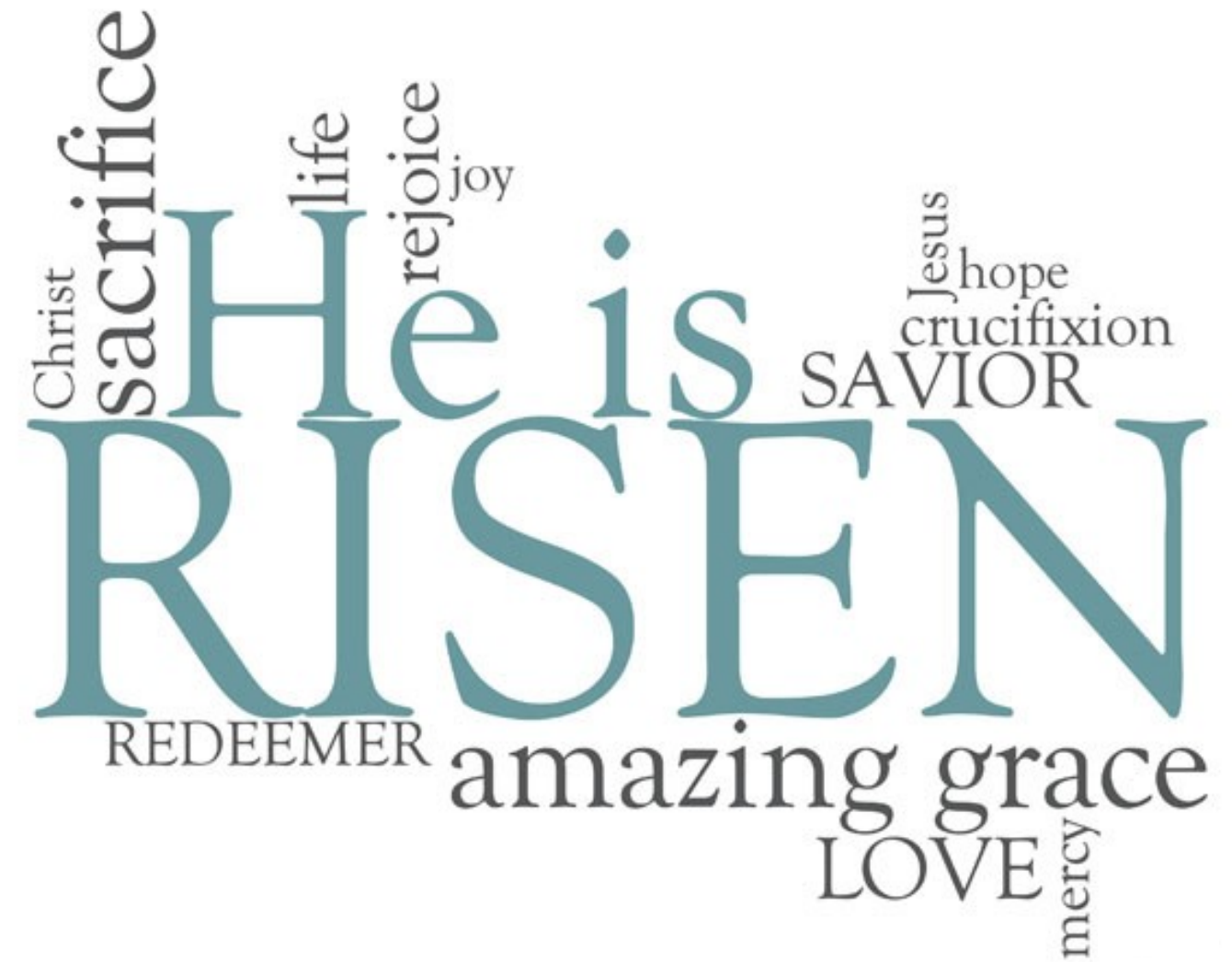
Sunday School is available for all ages starting at 9:00 a.m.
